

TRUMP^{Rx} FAQs



What is TrumpRx in simple terms?

TrumpRx is a government run website that helps people *look up discounted prices* on certain prescription drugs. It shows possible cash prices but does not sell medication itself.



Is TrumpRx an insurance plan?

No. TrumpRx is not insurance and does not replace your existing prescription coverage.



Can I use my insurance with TrumpRx?

No. TrumpRx prices are *cash pay only*. Private insurance, Medicare, and Medicaid cannot be used with TrumpRx pricing.



Do TrumpRx purchases count toward my deductible?

No. Because TrumpRx is cash pay only, what you spend will *not count toward your deductible or out of pocket maximum*.



Who is TrumpRx most useful for?

TrumpRx may be helpful for:

- People without prescription drug coverage
- Individuals with high-deductible health plans
- Patients whose medications are not covered by insurance
- Certain higher-cost drugs, such as some fertility or weight-loss medications



Are TrumpRx prices always the lowest available?

Not always. In many cases, *generic medications, insurance copays, or other discount programs* may cost you less. That's why it's best used as a comparison tool.



How many medications are included?

Only a *limited number of brand-name drugs* are currently available. The list may change over time as drug manufacturers join or leave the program.



Do I still need a prescription?

Yes. A valid prescription from your healthcare provider is required.



Is there a cost to use TrumpRx?

No. There is no fee to search the website or view prices.



What should I do before using TrumpRx?

- Check your insurance copay first
- Ask your provider if a generic option is available
- Compare prices across different options
- Consider how paying cash may affect your overall healthcare costs
